Alcester Academy has a small number of vacancies for Parent and Community Governors. No specific skills are required for this voluntary role. Appointments are for four years and the level of personal commitment to the role is very much the decision of the individual.

There are 7 meetings of full Governors each year, currently held in the early evening (6.00 – 8.00 pm) and 6 meetings of sub-committees. Each Governor is asked to be a member of a sub-committee although this is not compulsory. We have 3 such committees: Human Resources, Performance and Finance & Audit.

If Governors do have additional time available there are opportunities to support the Academy in many different ways, e.g. recruitment interviews, student behaviour processes, individual mentoring and assistance on external activities.

This is a role which people undertake, because they:

- Gain enjoyment and fulfilment
- Are able to see the value they add to the education of young people in their community
- Are able to understand much more of the education process
- Would be joining a board of Governors in the challenging Academy environment.

All new Governors are subject to a CRB check.
